Applicable Credit Sources

College credit may be granted on a case-by-case basis for prior learning only when it can be documented and falls within regular course credit offerings. Credits may be from the following sources:

- CLEP exams (67.5 quarter/45 semester units max)
- AP or IB exams (45 quarter/30 semester units max)
- Military experience or ACE evaluated military schools (135 Quarter/90 semester units max). Correspondence credit (9 Quarter/6 semester units max)
- POST (Peace Officer Standards & Training) up to 31.5 quarter units

- California Commission on Teacher Credentialing Teacher Induction Program up to 11.25 guarter units toward Master of Arts in Education
- Medical Lab Technician (MLT) from a CA** Laboratory Field Services (LFS) approved MLT training program (MLT to BSCLS) and MLT (ASCP) or MLT (AAB) examination may be awarded a maximum of up to 27 quarter units of Upper Division Electives towards BSCLS
- NCLEX (maximum of 31.5 quarter units may apply toward the baccalaureate nursing (RN to BSN) degree if a student has passed the NCLEX-RN examination)
- Clinical courses for RNs who have graduated from a three year hospital nursing school (45 quarter/30 semester units max. Up to 22.5 quarter/15 semester units of additional lower-division credit may be granted for academically equivalent coursework.)
- A maximum of 22.5 quarter/15 semester units may be earned for:
 - DSST Testing
 - Excelsior College Examinations
 - Council for Adult Experiential Learning (CAEL) Portfolio
 - Credit recommended in the National Guide to Credit Recommendations for Non-Collegiate Courses (American Council on Education [ACE])
 - Local, state, and federal law enforcement training recommended by ACE and such credit listed on a transcript from a regionally accredited college
 - Departmental examinations to potentially test out of a course at National University (Credit by Examination)
 - Sophia Learning, LLC Course Articulation
 - StraighterLine Course Articulation
 - Language Proficiency Testing

^{**}Individuals who have received an associate's Degree outside the state of CA in Medical Lab Technician and passed the ASCP or AAB can submit transcripts and certificates to determine eligibility.



^{*} College credit may be granted on a case-by-case basis for prior learning only when it can be documented and falls within regular course credit offerings. The maximum number of credits accepted for non-collegiate learning is a cumulative total of up to 135 Quarter units (90 semester units) for an associate or baccalaureate degree.
